Key Verses

Ecclesiastes 8:15 (NLT)

Discussion

1. What are some fun activities that you enjoyed growing up?
2. Are there any of these things you could resurrect and include in your current life?

Thinking back and reflecting upon your top five moments from the past year is a great way to highlight the amazing experiences that you have enjoyed, as well as, helping to define activities and experiences you would like to make happen in the upcoming year (concerts, vacations, and even favorite restaurants).

3. What are your top five moments from this past year?
4. What are some themes that you notice from your top 5 moments? In what ways can you ensure those themes are present in this coming year?

Most people picture God as the police in the sky, but God desires us to have fun. In Ecclesiastes 8:15, the Bible says, "So I recommend having fun, because there is nothing better for people in this world than to eat, drink, and enjoy life."
