Key Verses

Joshua 24:15 (NIV)

"But if serving the LORD seems undesirable to you, then choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve, whether the gods your ancestors served beyond the Euphrates, or the gods of the Amorites, in whose land you are living. But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD."

Discussion

A new year brings new opportunities to improve our lives and created new plans for our families, faith, and our future. There are endless goals that you can have for your family in the new year, but aligning them with your faith will help ensure that you see enduring success.

- 1. What did faith look like in your family growing up?
- 2. As you look ahead to this year, what would you like your family and faith to look like?

If we start with our faith foundation and ask ourselves, "How can I set a better example as a Christ-follower to my own family?," we are awarded the opportunity to lead by example to those around us.

In Joshua 24:15, Joshua declares, "But as for me and my household, we will serve the LORD." This action voices and anchors his intentions of how he will live his family life with God at the center. You too can choose to make the same declaration to grow with God through your family goals.

- 6. How will you take lead and serve your family?
